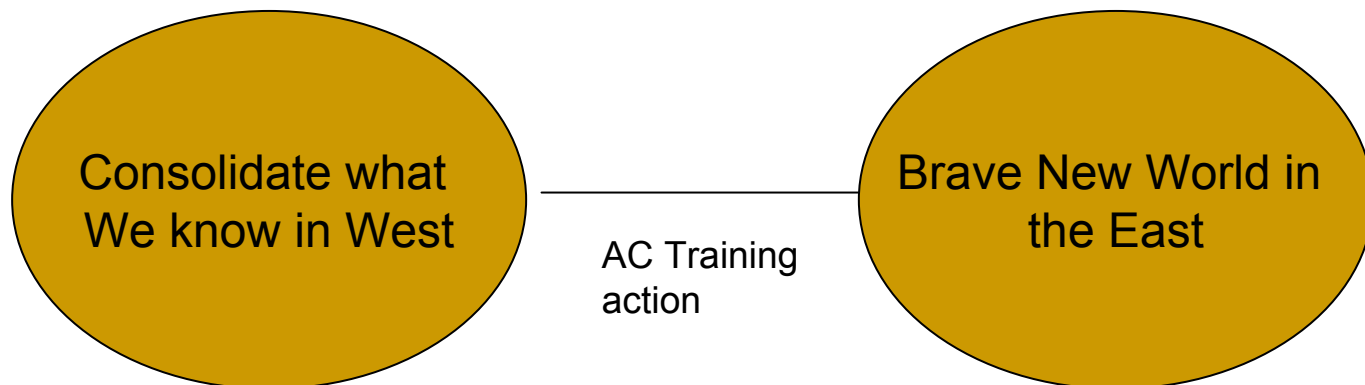

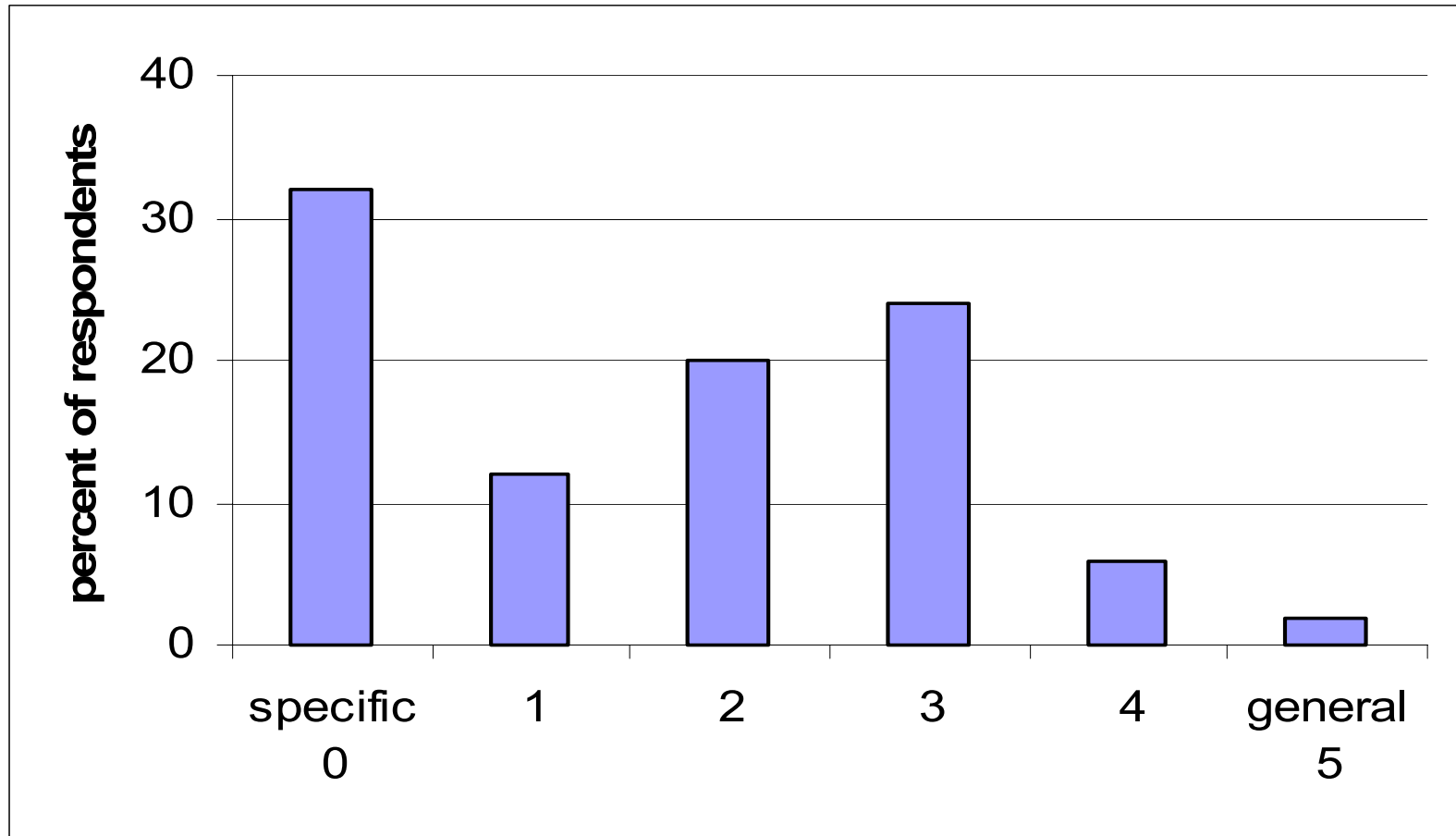
# Anti-Corruption Training: Problems and Prospects

Simulation: An Individualised method of dealing with ethics/anticorruption

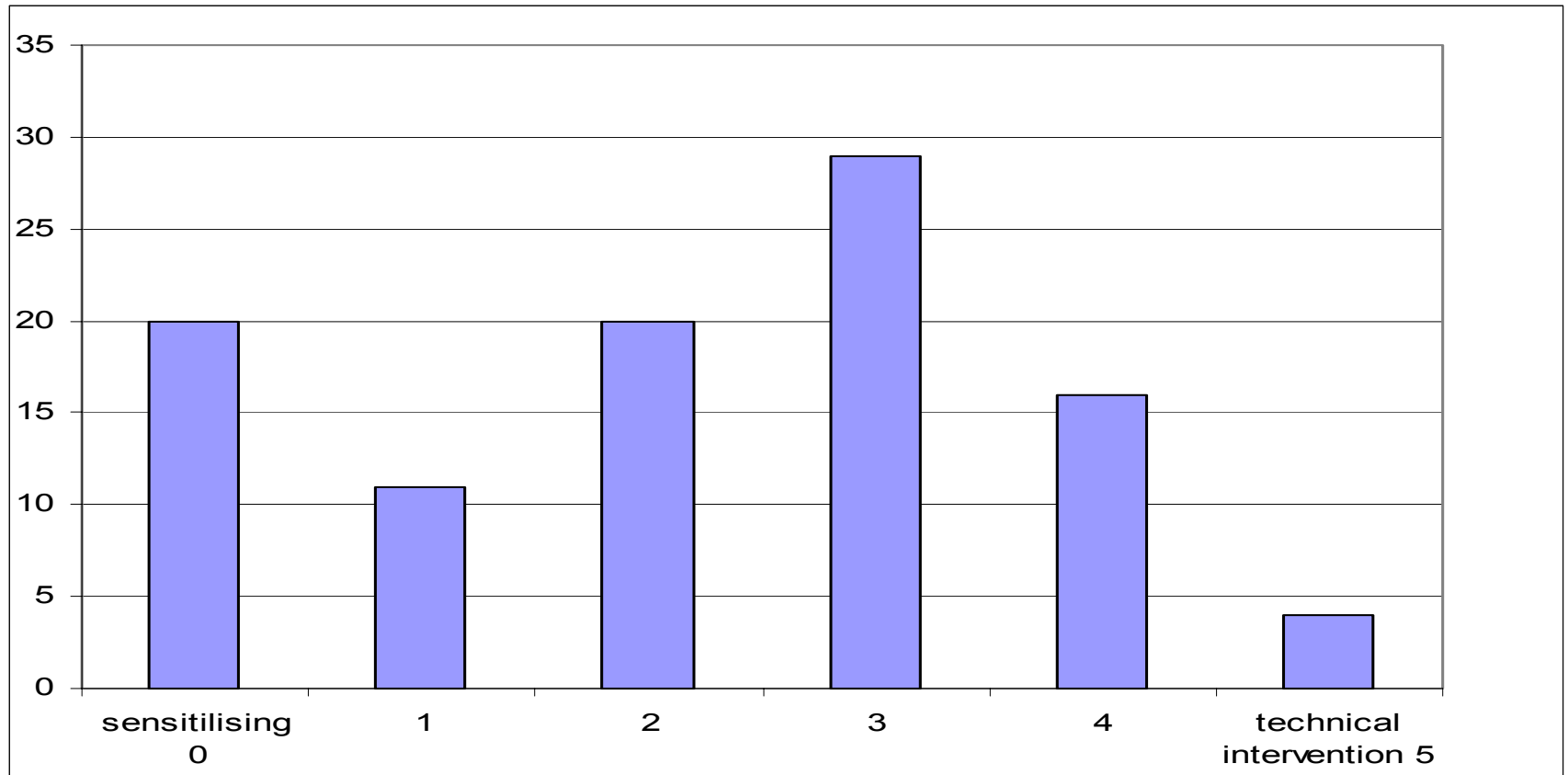


# Question 1: Would you recommend specific or general training activities?



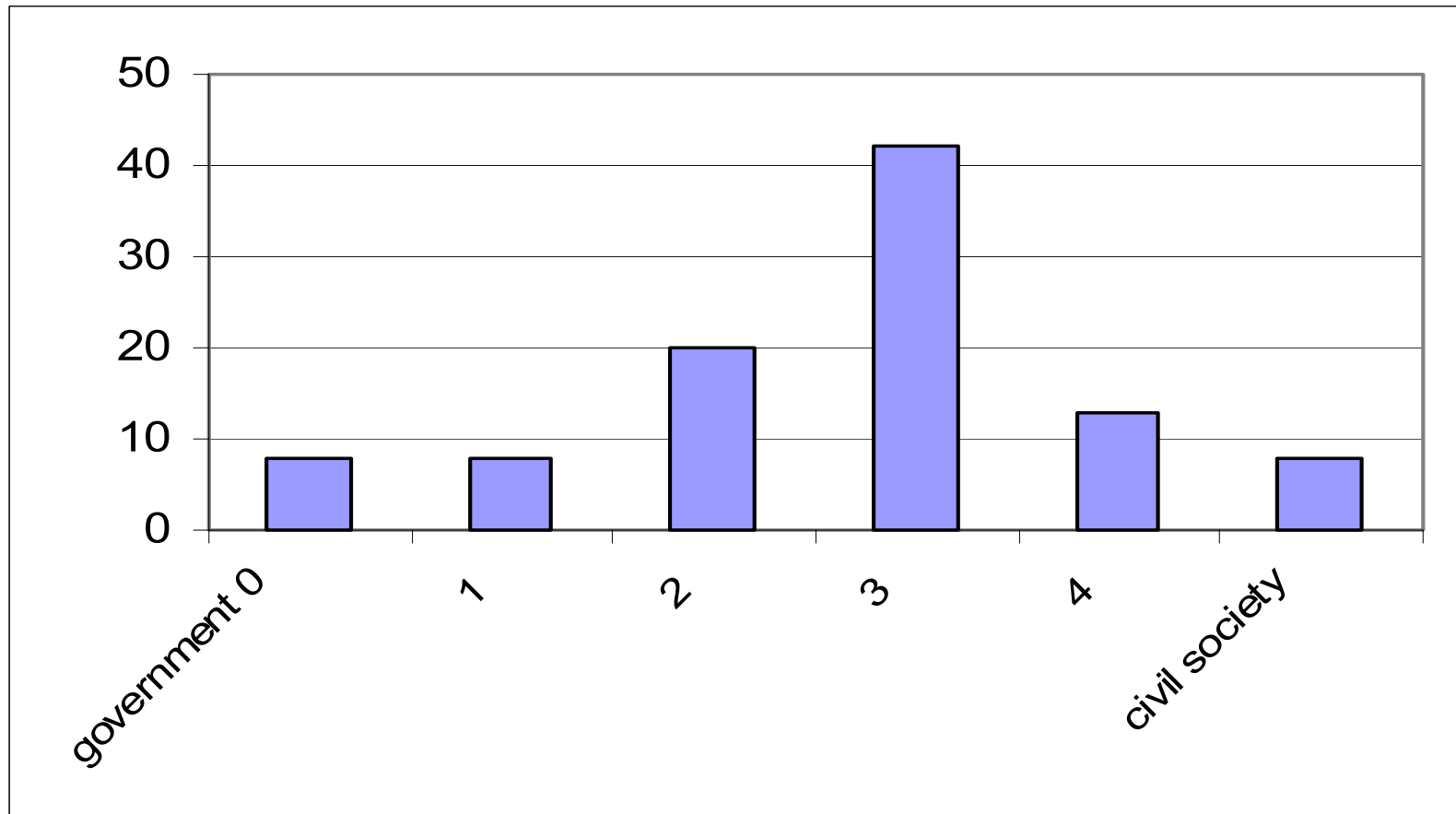
*The average response for this question is: 1,6*

## Question 2: Awareness raising or technical interventions?



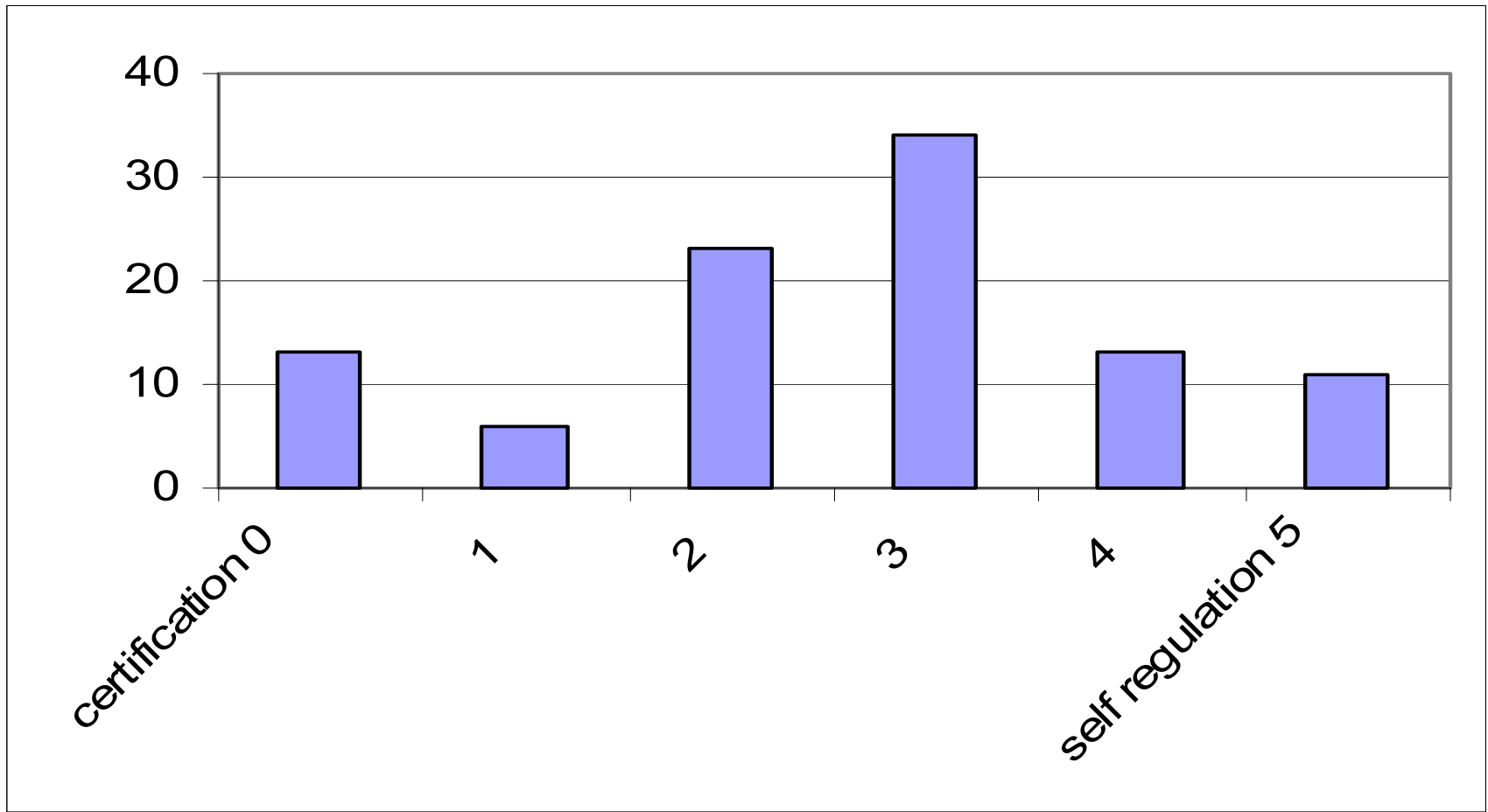
*The average response for this question is: 2,3*
